3.00pm on Sunday 9 June


Our annual pilgrimage from St Luke’s, Tutshill, to the ruins of St James’ church, Lancaut.

Last year across the parish these bank charges amounted to some £200, so it would help enormously, if you could set up a standing order. which is the formal name of our church bank account. Banks have recently tightened up on cheque payments, so if you write ‘St Luke’s Tutshill’, or ‘Tutshill Church’ etc, it is likely that it won’t be accepted by our bank, or indeed by your own! We are charged £25 every time a cheque bounces!
