PCC Secretary

We are urgently seeking a volunteer to be our new PCC Secretary, as the position is vacant. This is a key role ensuring the PCC runs effectively and efficiently whilst complying with its legal and statutory duties. The person filling the role does not need to be a PCC member and is a key leadership role in Tidenham Parish.

It should only take 40hrs of effort per year on an ad hoc basis and is a fulfilling way of supporting our PCC and parishioners in delivering our parish vision of 'Living Life Together in the Flow of God's Love' and growing His Kingdom in this beautiful part of the world.

The role comprises:

- PCC Secretariat, producing the agendas for PCC meetings, recording and signing off the minutes with the PCC and following up on actions with those taking the actions.

LATEST UPDATE - THE VACANCY FOR OUR VICAR

Work is well underway between Tidenham, St. Briavels and Hewelsfield with Brockweir Parishes on our joint statement of vision, direction, needs, wants, challenges and benefits. The statement focuses on a shared benefices identity, whilst highlighting the unique qualities and requirements of each Parish within this. It will be used to help attract the best candidate we can. Our editorial board meets regularly to work on this document.

We have been consulting with you in two ways. Firstly, a brief questionnaire was circulated in our churches and local communities and the consultation is now closed. Your responses will be incorporated into the drafts of the vacancy statement. We will be holding a Parish open day on Saturday 30 November in the newly re-ordered North Aisle of St Mary & St Peter's Tidenham from 10.00am-1.00pm, when you can review the document and chat to PCC members.

The Archdeacon will sign off the final version by Friday 20 December and advertisements for the role will run in the Church Times in January and February. Interviews will take place early March (the panel will comprise Bishop(s), the Archdeacon and five PCC members (three from Tidenham and one each from St. Briavels and Hewelsfield.) We expect the new incumbent to arrive late summer, after serving any notice in their current role.

We will keep you updated, but in the meantime please contact Revd Nicki for pastoral and Churchwardens, Brian or Robin, for non-pastoral matters. And we also have a special prayer to help us with the vacancy:

Heavenly Father, during this vacancy, guard and grow the Parishes of Tidenham, St Briavels and Hewelsfield, as we serve you together in this period without a Priest in Charge.

Lord Jesus, we know you have plans for us and that these plans are good. We ask you now that You will help us to share responsibility, grow in faith, love one another, care for those in need, reach out to others, and welcome newcomers.

Holy Spirit, please guide those who are seeking the right person for us, and those who are seeking the right place for their ministry, that together we may discover Your way for the future and see Your Kingdom grow.

All this we ask in the strength of the Holy Trinity. Amen.
