CONTACTS DURING THE VACANCY FOR OUR VICAR

Whilst there is a vacancy for our Parish vicar, please contact Revd Nicki for pastoral matters and for non-pastoral matters, please contact our Churchwardens, Brian or Robin. Also visit our Parish website for specific contacts or see below.

The Churchwardens have all the up-to-date information and will keep you posted as things develop. Briefly, the position cannot be advertised until the New Year, as there is quite a lot to do with developing the Parish Profile (a detailed specification/mission statement), which includes St Briavels & Hewelsfield, and approving this with the Diocese; you will be invited to give your views at the appropriate time. We are therefore planning to have a new vicar in post in 12 months' time. And this is all subject to developing the old vicarage site on Gloucester Road, which will include a new Parish Vicarage; plans for this follow Diocese guidelines and will be available to view through the usual channels in due course.

Whilst the Churchwardens and Ministry Team will be running our Parish during the vacancy and endeavouring to minimise any disruption caused by the vacancy, please bear with us if they have to make priority decisions based on available resources.

We hope this answers your immediate questions, but please talk to the Churchwardens or PCC members, if there is anything else. Don't forget that we have a wonderful team to support everyone in church and in the community and all our gatherings throughout the Parish will run as normal.

We also have a special prayer to help us with the vacancy:

Heavenly Father, during this vacancy, guard and grow the Parishes of Tidenham, St Briavels and Hewelsfield, as we serve you together in this period without a Priest in Charge.

Lord Jesus, we know you have plans for us and that these plans are good. We ask you now that You will help us to share responsibility, grow in faith, love one another, care for those in need, reach out to others, and welcome newcomers.

Holy Spirit, please guide those who are seeking the right person for us, and those who are seeking the right place for their ministry, that together we may discover Your way for the future and see Your Kingdom grow.

All this we ask in the strength of the Holy Trinity. Amen.

ST MARY & ST PETER'S TIDENHAM - The preparation phase for the re-ordering at Tidenham is proceeding well. The pews have been moved from the North Aisle, a water supply has been laid to the church and drains laid very carefully through the churchyard. There are reinforcings on the grass and ramps into the church to improve wheelchair and mobility scooter access; the ramps reused wood from some of the pews. Do come and see the progress and join us for services; once all the work is complete, the church will be open more often. The recent Cheese & Wine event was very well attended and showed everyone the potential that has been unlocked and the work to follow. There will be some plastering and painting in August and the main work will start in September.
