During this time we have helped over 140 families, seen 40 of them go **DEBT FREE**, clearing a whopping **£637,282.91**, either through a Debt Management Plan, or a DRO. We have also helped so many more families learn how to budget and manage their finances by themselves.

A big thank you to those who took part in this year's Ride+Stride sponsored walk to raise funds for Gloucester Historic Churches Trust. Walkers were Rev Nicky, James, Anthony and George, with Brian Duerden joining them for the leg from Tidenham Chase church to Tidenham church. Also, a big thank you to all those who sponsored the walkers; a total of £565 was donated, which, after Gift Aid, amounts to £695, and half of this amount is returned to our PCC towards our own maintenance works. And finally, a big thank you to Sarah-Jane Gilchrist and the Friends of Tidenham Parish Church for laying on refreshments at Tidenham Church.

GARAS have sent their thanks for our donation of £186.05 which will help them in their important work. GARAS (Gloucestershire Action for Refugees and Asylum Seekers) offers support to those seeking asylum in Gloucestershire, welcoming them when they arrive, advocating for them in their daily struggles, supporting them if they face being sent back as well as helping them adjust to their long term future if they are recognised as refugees

THE VACANCY FOR OUR VICAR - UPDATE

The three PCCs of Tidenham, St. Briavels and Hewelsfield met recently with Archdeacon Hilary, the Diocesan Senior Interim Minister, the Forest South Area Dean and Lay Chair to hear the latest progress on the vacancy and ask questions/raise issues. This meeting was the first in several “legal” meetings that need to take place around the recruitment for a replacement for Revd David.

We were very happy to hear that our benefices are highly thought of in terms of the role of Vicar of Tidenham (with Lancaut and Beachley) and Priest in Charge of St. Briavels and Hewelsfield that Revd David occupied. Archdeacon Hilary again confirmed that the role would be replaced with the current benefice and parish responsibilities that Revd David held.

We do have an opportunity, however, to take the development of our parishes to the next level of evolution, through a statement of needs, wants, challenges and benefits surrounding the role in this wonderful part of God’s world. With prayer, wide consultation and an attractive proposition, we expect to be in a position for a new incumbent to start in summer 2025.

The Diocese and Deanery will work closely on the recruitment process in conjunction with the five church wardens in the Benefices. Parishioners will be consulted on the content of the statement of vision, direction, needs, wants, challenges and benefits, with input from the PCCs, the Deanery and the Diocese. The statement will focus on a shared benefices identity, whilst highlighting the unique qualities and requirements of each parish within this. The more attractive we make and “sell” the role, the more likely we are to attract the ideal candidate!

A first draft of the statement will be circulated in October for consultation, with a sign off by Archdeacon Hilary in December leading to an advert going out in the Church Times and on our social media networks in January. A panel, including five of our joint PCC members (yet to volunteer/be selected), will then undertake shortlisting of applicants ready for interview. Interviews will take place in March and there will be informal opportunities to meet the candidates around the formal interviews by the panel.

It is important that we reflect the diversity of our parishes and parishioners to the candidates and let them know how vibrant our communities are and what opportunities there are to take us all forward in our spiritual journeys and doing God’s work.

We expect the new incumbent to arrive in the summer, after serving any notice in their current role.

Please contact Revd Nicki for pastoral and Churchwardens, Brian or Robin, for non-pastoral matters. And we also have a special prayer to help us with the vacancy:

Heavenly Father, during this vacancy, guard and grow the Parishes of Tidenham, St Briavels and Hewelsfield, as we serve you together in this period without a Priest in Charge.

Lord Jesus, we know you have plans for us and that these plans are good. We ask you now that You will help us to share responsibility, grow in faith, love one another, care for those in need, reach out to others, and welcome newcomers.

Holy Spirit, please guide those who are seeking the right person for us, and those who are seeking the right place for their ministry, that together we may discover Your way for the future and see Your Kingdom grow.

All this we ask in the strength of the Holy Trinity. Amen.
